<u>VISION STATEMENT:</u> "The City of El Dorado stewards entrusted resources by intentionally facilitating and growing internal and external relationships to create an unsurpassed community, the desirable place we call home."

MISSION STATEMENT: "Enhancing Quality of Life by Embracing Service Excellence."

## **CORE VALUES:**

Responsibility – Taking personal ownership and accountability for all expectations of self and duty.

Respect – Unbiased consideration, understanding, and regard for the rights, values, beliefs, and property of all people.

Stewardship – An obligation to protect and manage community resources.

Integrity – Honesty, acting within a code of right conduct or ethical behaviors that reflect our moral foundation.

*Excellence* – Working with passion to exceed standards and maximize talents to achieve the best outcomes for our customers and organization.

*Innovation* – Continuously expand on new ideas by creating new processes while being open to changes in day-to-day activities.

#### **STRATEGIC PRIORITIES:**

- **I.** <u>Fiscal Stewardship</u> The City of El Dorado will manage taxpayer resources in a prudent manner by acting as a responsible steward of public resources.
  - a. Develop a *balanced operating budget* that maintains funding levels without requiring an increase to the mill levy.
  - b. *Forecast the financial condition of the City* over a five-year period to provide service delivery at acceptable levels while anticipating upcoming changes to finances.
  - c. Develop a *debt management plan* that allows for the prudent issuance of municipal debt to meet the infrastructure needs of the community without requiring the need for an increase to the mill levy.
  - d. Adopt and implement a *multi-year Capital Improvement Plan* that provides for the replacement of existing public infrastructure while also providing a mechanism for growth opportunities.
  - e. Adopt a *Fleet Replacement Plan* that provides for the practical replacement of the municipal fleet in a manner that reduces maintenance expenses and avoids disruptions in service delivery.

- **II.** <u>Municipal Workforce</u> The City of El Dorado desires to create a municipal organization that attracts and retains talented and creative individuals dedicated to serving the citizens of El Dorado.
  - a. Nurture an *organizational culture that attracts and retains talented individuals* who wish to serve in municipal government and who exemplify the culture and values of the organization.
  - b. Create and maintain a *compensation structure* that attracts and retains talented individuals, incentivizes performance, and maintains regional competitiveness.
  - c. Facilitate the *development of knowledge*, *skills*, *and abilities* of all individuals within the organization to enable the organization to meet the service delivery expectations of the community.
  - d. Develop the *leadership capacity* within the organization to promote a culture of excellence through supervision, coaching and mentoring, and accountability.
- **III.** <u>Infrastructure</u> The City invests in its public infrastructure to ensure that the community has the most basic resources necessary to thrive and prosper.
  - a. Adopt and implement a *multi-year Capital Improvement Plan* that provides for the replacement of existing public infrastructure while also providing a mechanism for growth opportunities.
  - b. Continuously *evaluate public facilities* to ensure that such facilities receive proper investment for maintenance, and facilitate the planning of new or renovation of such facilities when needed to maintain service delivery.
  - c. Develop a long-term finance plan to prudently manage and pay off debt obligations associated with *water storage capacity* at El Dorado Lake.
  - d. Evaluate funding options for continued investment in critical public infrastructure.
  - e. Continuously *invest in public safety* initiatives, equipment, and technology to provide the El Dorado Police and Fire Departments with the resources needed to preserve order and protect life and property.
- **IV.** <u>Economic Development</u> The City actively works to create an environment that facilitates capital investment, produces jobs, and increases the tax base of the community.
  - a. Facilitate the *proactive recruitment of industrial development opportunities* that leverage El Dorado's physical and intangible assets.
  - b. Market El Dorado's *industrial and business parks* as prime sites for development opportunities.
  - c. Actively collaborate with downtown stakeholders to *facilitate revitalization efforts in downtown* El Dorado.
  - d. Create an environment that nurtures and *supports entrepreneurs* that seek to establish new business ventures in the community.
  - e. Facilitate *workforce development* opportunities with regional stakeholders to provide workers with the skills needed for a constantly changing, competitive economy.

- f. Collaborate with area developers and builders to facilitate the development of *housing opportunities* that meet the needs of the community.
- **V. Quality of Life** The City of El Dorado desires to create a place where people choose to live and visit.
  - a. Coordinate *recreation opportunities at El Dorado Lake* that attract visitors and enhance the quality of life for residents.
  - b. Develop *recreation opportunities beyond traditional sports* to provide citizens with enhanced ways to socialize and exercise.
  - c. *Strengthen existing offerings in traditional sports* to provide the best experience for participants while creating an environment that fosters learning and development and creates fun experiences.
  - d. Market El Dorado and its many events and experiences to residents and visitors.
  - e. Develop *fun and engaging events and activities* that provide people with something to do after work and school.
  - f. Facilitate the *reduction of blight* in El Dorado by proactively identifying and addressing vacant and abandoned housing and blighted properties.
- **VI.** <u>Municipal Operations</u> The City embraces service delivery excellence and seeks to facilitate innovation of services and continuous improvement for the betterment of the community.
  - a. Create an organizational culture that strives for *customer service excellence* through practical implementation of the City's core values and behavioral norms.
  - b. Seek *continuous improvement* within the organization to reduce costs, increase efficiencies, and make municipal programs more effective for citizens.
  - c. Facilitate *citizen-centric thinking* by actively engaging citizens to determine ways to serve the public in a manner and at a cost desired by the community.
  - d. Promote a *culture of innovation* where employees may experiment and develop new ways of providing municipal services for the benefit of the public.
