DATE: January 29, 2020

Background:

City staff established two routes in 2015 for use by organizations who wanted to hold a parade in El Dorado. After utilizing these routes, it was determined that the long route was not efficient for the organizations nor the City of El Dorado. Staff switched to utilizing only the short route as it provided the safest most efficient route and did not block downtown businesses and parking for a significant amount of time. USD 490 and El Dorado Main Street have been utilizing a different route for their Homecoming and Christmas parades, respectively.

Staff are recommending that the City Commission establish the short route as the only eligible parade route in El Dorado.
